- 18-28 years old
- is single, not married, not pregnant & has never given birth

- 29+ years old
- Is single, divorced, widowed, with or without children




MRS.

ALL DIVISIONS

WARDROBE REQUIREMENTS




SWIM | FITNESS

DOCUMENTS

DOCUMENTS & DEADLINES

To compete in the Pageant, you **MUST** turn in the following:

- Official Online Application-Due Immediately
- Deposit- Due with Official Application
- Official Paperwork-Due within 48 hours of receiving in official Welcome Letter/Email
 - Title holder's agreement Signed
 - Credit Card Authorization Form (Only used if in violation of contract or on delinquent accounts)
 - Photo/Advertising release
- Headshot: Professional photo due within 30 days, No sash and crowns allowed for announcement
- Copy of Birth Certificate, Naturalization, or permanent resident card
- Copy of drivers license or identification card
- Final divorce decree for any previously married Miss & Ms. Contestants
- Ad Page artwork/\$299 fee/forms (as soon as they are ready, but **NO LATER** than one month before pageant)
- Mrs. – copy of marriage license
- Any other documents requested by director
- Judges Bio- 5 hard copies, typed (3 weeks prior to pageant mailed to state pageant office)

A late fee of \$150 will be incurred if all required payments and documents are not received by the deadline. ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE

BACKSTAGE & PAGEANT ETIQUETTE

BACKSTAGE

NO ONE is allowed in the backstage dressing area during the pageant other than the contestant, staff, and exclusive sponsors for hair and makeup. If the contestant is 13 or 14 years of age, she may have one female escort. You may bring your own full size mirror. NO tolerance for vandalism to anyone else property. All trash must be disposed of properly. Room cleaned up at end of competition. Absolutely no cell phone use will be permitted during the pageant backstage.

PAGEANT ETIQUETTE

None of these things will win or lose a pageant for you. However, once you have entered the pageant everyone is watching you, and it is important to make a good impression. These guidelines will help you create an impression of a responsible, confident, organized individual who can handle any job given to her.

- Meet every deadline, or call for an extension!
- Follow all rules! They are for your safety and security.
- Be neat and clean! No one should have to pick up after you.
- Be organized! It is your responsibility to know what's happening and be ready.
- Get acquainted! You should get to know the other contestants, the contestant coordinators, and our Team. Most importantly, be respectful to everyone!
- Be complimentary of all accommodations and meals! Sponsors and staff always do their best, please remember that.
- Be cheerful even if you are not "the winner." Only one person can win the crown, and you are already a winner for representing with your local title!
- Be a gracious winner! It happens once in a lifetime, and many others would like to be in your shoes!

CROWNING & AWARDS

Miss Congeniality

This special award is voted by the contestants and will be given to the young lady who is most embodies sisterhood, gives support, and has good sportsmanship despite it being a competition!

People's Choice

We will have voting 3 weeks prior to the pageant for our People's Choice Recipient. Voting costs are \$1 per vote. There will be no limit on votes per person and feel free to solicit votes from friends, family, and social media followers from all over the world.

FAQ'S

Do I have to compete in and win a preliminary competition in order to compete in the national pageant?

Yes, Pennsylvania and New Jersey have a state competition that you must compete in order to go to the national pageant. Other states may or may not have local preliminaries available in your area, if there is not a preliminary pageant in your state apply directly with the national office.

How long does it take to receive my sash and crown?

Once the sash is ordered it generally takes 3-6 weeks for production.

When do tickets go on sale?

Tickets typically go on sale 2-4 weeks prior to the pageant. You will be notified when they go on sale and given instructions on how to purchase tickets.

Do children under 5 need a ticket?

YES! EVERYONE needs a ticket.

Will the pageant be televised?

We are hoping for USOA TV on our website, details TBA.

Are there any required rehearsals prior to the pageant?

No. All rehearsals will take place during pageant weekend. Optional workshop tentatively scheduled for August and Zoom workshops.

How do I sell advertisements in the program book to raise money towards my pageant expenses?

Once you are registered as a contestant, you will be provided a sponsorship letter to present to businesses, friends and family whom may wish to support you by either purchasing an advertisement to simply wish you good luck or to promote and highlight their business!
